JUDGMENT, SENTENCE AND COMMITMENT

The Defendant was charged by Criminal Information with the commission on January 18, 1995, of the felony crime of Count 1, Driving While Under the Influence of Intoxicating Liquor or Drugs, Fourth or Subsequent Offense.

On July 27, 1995, the Defendant was found guilty by a jury of the crime as charged in the Criminal Information. (The State dismissed Count 2). On August 21, 1995, the Court sentenced the Defendant. The State of New Mexico was represented by Alan J. Griffin, Assistant District Attorney, at the trial and sentencing proceedings. The Defendant was present and represented by Sheri Raphaelson, attorney-at-law, at the trial and sentencing proceedings.

THE JUDGMENT AND SENTENCE OF THE COURT IS THEREFORE AS FOLLOWS:

The Defendant is sentenced to EIGHTEEN (18) MONTHS in the custody of the Corrections Department to be followed by ONE (1) YEAR on parole under the supervision of the Field Services Division
