

with his family. That would explain many things about Meeks' testimony, especially why he had to testify from the script prepared for him by investigating agents. 22 R.R. 45-47. It was so evident that Meeks was testifying from his statement prepared by law enforcement as opposed to his memory that on direct examination, the prosecution interrupted Meeks to remark, "You keep looking down at your lap. Do you have a prepared statement there?" Meeks, of course, answered in the affirmative. 22 R.R. 45. The defense objected that Meeks was "reading from a document." *Id.* at 46. In short, Meeks' trial evidence is not evidence of guilt. Meeks' testimony was manufactured using Kim's relatively harmless statements to ATF agents as a template. Meeks was then coerced by law enforcement with threats of prosecution for capital murder into adopting a fabulous and incredible soap operatic story, complete with unnamed Samoans making contracts for hits outside movie theaters, briefcase bombs of which Meeks was allowed a quick glimpse, "missions," and, finally, betrayal.

Kim's testimony did not connect Michael Toney to any bombing, and her testimony that she, Meeks, and Toney went to a building where Toney left a briefcase and then to the Nature Center on Thanksgiving Day was incontestably inaccurate.⁴⁶ Given that Toney did not possess the truck, the toolbox, or the .22 rifle that he shot a beaver with until *after* Thanksgiving Day, it is impossible for Kim's memory to be correct. Tammy Reil's affidavit proves as much, in that she recalls seeing Toney on Thanksgiving evening in his Monza sometime between 8:30 and 9:00 p.m. Charles "Jack" Ferris' affidavit confirms Toney's and Bennie Joe Toole's testimony at trial that Toney only heard about the Lake Worth bombing through Toole, who had been involved in the investigation, and that Ferris only delivered Toney's name to authorities as part

⁴⁶ When first approached by law enforcement, Kim did not have any knowledge of any bombing in the Lake Worth area. It was not until she went to a library and researched the bombing that she recalled being in the area at one time in her life. She assumed, perhaps because like others she was told by the agents they had hard scientific proof Toney was responsible, that she was in the area with Toney on Thanksgiving Day. She was not.
